Includes personalized payment plans and customized financial assistance for each family. We award \$2 million to 45% of students.

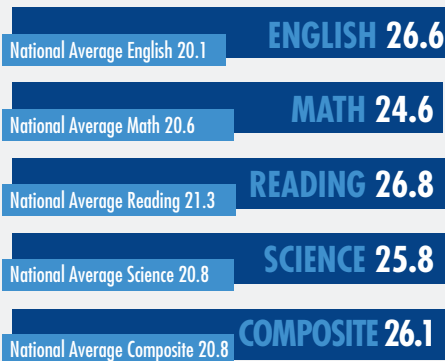
84% of the faculty have master's degrees and four have doctoral degrees.

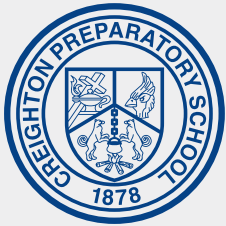
