

Prep Moms (formerly called Mothers' Club) began in 1933 by the Rev. B.J. Murray, S. J. with much the same mission that we have today! Now as we enter our seventy-sixth year in existence it is good to reflect back. As you can see from the following quotes taken from various yearbooks, the significance of a mother's involvement in her son's life is just as important today as it was 25, 50, and 76 years ago. We may hold different fundraisers and face different challenges today compared to those mothers of days gone by, but our love for our sons is just as strong.

The 1940 year book stated,

"Since its inception seven years ago, the Mothers' Club has proved to be of great assistance to the school. Motivated by a deep loyalty and a spirit of self sacrifice that has always characterized the club, the mothers of the Prep students have organized card parties, frolics, and most enjoyable of all – 'Fathers Night'. No year has passed that did not see the activities of these Prep Mothers climaxed with a reassuring success. No year has gone by that did not see more enthusiastic friends won for Prep-friends that have come to know and admire our school through acquaintance with the members of the Prep Mothers' Club."

This appeared in the 1953 Creighton Prep yearbook,

"Reflecting upon this, the seventy-fifth anniversary of our school, it is readily apparent that the Creighton Prep of 1878 had many harassing problems. These numerous problems could have been considerably less burdensome if there had been an organization comparable to the Mothers' Club of today. The untiringly faithful members of this organization have indeed shown themselves to be the friends of Creighton Prep."

As the Mothers' Club celebrated its 25th anniversary in 1958, the yearbook stated,

"For twenty-five years, the Mothers' Club has been a vital part of Creighton Prep. The club was organized to give parents and teachers an opportunity to meet and discuss problems. The idea of parent and teacher working together for the welfare of a boy has contributed much to the success of Prep. Through the years the Mothers' Club has contributed tremendously in aiding the school financially and in furnishing scholarships to the worthy students."
