Creighton Preparatory School forms men of faith, scholarship, leadership and service in the Catholic and Jesuit tradition.

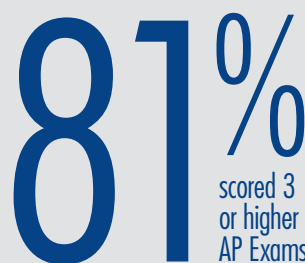


PREP GRADUATES ATTEND A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY.

154 out of 240 students earned **685 Scholarships** that totaled approximately **\$25,928,424**.

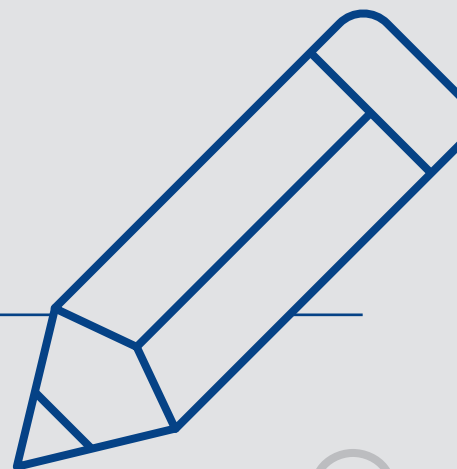
Over **11,000 active alumni** with members located in every state in the Union and in over 17 countries throughout the world; 6,500 are local.
