Good to have Mr. Bopp here. • Loyola Scholars: 15 boys are participating in the program. They attended summer school at Prep and attend class every Saturday morning to prepare for the Catholic Schools entrance exam. • Commons: Lunch program started out rough, but it's worked itself out. Now lunch is served within 11 minutes, the process has continued to improve. • Baseball Field: Will be getting new turf. The North parking lot will be expanded. • Ignatius Carbon Challenge: Staff are focusing on this. "Prep" shoes were purchased for the staff to wear. Staff earn the shoes by doing service at a service site our boys participate at during the year. • Strategic Plan: Working on plans for a while, board is looking seriously at this process, involving staff and asking "What do we want Prep to look like in 2028? We have been touched by interactions throughout town, amazing how impactful Prep is on the community and how welcoming you have been to me and my family.” Mr. Bopp presented a brief bio.</p> <p>Freshman/Transfer Welcome Dinner: Thanks to those that put this on.</p> <p>Updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 26.1 Average ACT Score of our students last year, we had 7 National Merit Finalists • Baseball team went to the World Series • Omaha World-Herald reported Prep as “Omaha All Sports Champions” nine of the past 10 years. • Drug & Alcohol Testing Report – Last year, 76% of students tested, 22 got tested twice, 25 students (3.5%) tested positive. • New Faculty Position, “Director of Student Advocacy & Outreach.” This position supports students and families facing challenges. • Student Success Committee formed. Staff look at students who appear on the radar, they are looking for ways to help support students • IPad & Canvas: Learning curve for both faculty & staff, off to good start.
