Principal's Report	<p>Discussion: Mr. Bopp covered several topics in his report, here are the highlights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Advanced Education Accreditation</u> Mr. Bopp and Father Neitzke shared that Prep had completed the accreditation process for "College Preparatory" designation. Prep received a very strong endorsement. One area where Prep scored the highest was in "Stable Leadership." It will be five more years until Prep has to go through the accreditation review again. • <u>Jesuit Sponsorship Review</u> This accreditation will occur next year. The Provincial decides if Prep is able to keep the Jesuit endorsement. • <u>STEM</u> There was a pilot active learning classroom this year. Construction will be ongoing this summer which will create a new innovation center that will facilitate the addition of innovative curriculum. CAD, robotics and coding are some of the courses that will be offered at Prep in the future. • <u>New Football Coach</u> Prep has hired Tim Johnk as the new head football coach. • <u>New Football Helmets</u> All Prep football players will have new helmets in the fall. Each player will have a concussion monitoring helmet that is equipped with sensors that monitor impact and alert coaches for possible concussions that require further evaluation of a player. • <u>Enrollment</u> Prep's incoming freshman class is currently full with 283 boys accepted and there is a waiting list for the class of 2021. • <u>Parking Lot Expansion</u> Father Neitzke shared that there is a north parking lot expansion project that is ongoing. This will create an entrance into Prep from Seward Street. • <u>School Updates</u> Some remodeling of hallways and lockers will occur this summer. In fact, Prep lockers will be on sale at BASH! • <u>Tennis Courts</u> Father Neitzke shared that there has been discussion about adding tennis courts on the east side of the school. • <u>BASH</u> Plan to attend BASH on April 22nd.
